## Rules Corner

It's time to provide a few reminders.

Do not rely on someone in the proshop to give you correct information about the rules. The local rules for CMGC are different than CWGC. When in doubt, play 2 balls, declaring which one you believe is the correct rule interpretation and get an answer after the round. Email [cwgc.rules@gmail.com](mailto:cwgc.rules@gmail.com). Please pick up a copy of the CWGC local rules in the club room and put it in your bag.

If you swing at the golf ball with the intention of hitting it then it counts as a stroke whether you hit the ball or not.

You incur a one stroke penalty in the bunker for each of these occurrences:

You ground your club in front of or behind the ball  
Your club touches the sand during a practice swing  
Your club touches the sand during your backswing
